work travel, health, or major life events. Absences for vacations and other pleasure/leisure activities will not be accommodated. If you will be absent from a class, it is imperative that you notify the faculty in as far advance as possible and to also make your absence known to the MBA team. However, even with an approved absence, missing classes can potentially affect your participation and grades.

Online Courses

To maximize the breadth of courses we are able to provide, optional elective classes are delivered online. This allows us to be creative with the curriculum while still offering outstanding classes.

The online space is very rigorous. Sometimes more discipline is needed to complete the assigned deliverables and weekly assignments. Online courses are NOT self-paced. They are intended to give you flexibility, not tying you to a specific class time. Group work, exams, weekly assignments, discussions, and so on are still expected to be completed by the scheduled and outlined due dates for each class.

Similar to your in-person classes, missing or late assignments will result in lower scores or grades. While your physical presence in class is not necessary, it is expected that you will have internet access available to you to complete coursework. If you have extenuating circumstances and will be unable to complete coursework by the assigned deadlines please contact the faculty and the Evening MBA team to discuss.
