Can develop solutions, alternative practices, recommend new systems, procedures, or organizational changes.  <b>Tech Skills:</b> Data Visualization, Programming Languages (SQL, Python, R)
<b>Operations Management/ Supply Chain</b>	Amazon, Raytheon, Target, Walmart	Supply Chain Analyst, Operations Manager, Supply Chain Consultant	Plan, oversee, and coordinate the operations of a company. Typical responsibilities include procurement (acquiring goods and services from external sources), managing relations, and improving a company's use of resources.  <b>Tech Skills:</b> Microsoft Excel, Data Visualization, Programming Languages (SQL)
<b>Systems Analysis</b>	JP Morgan, Goldman Sachs	Business Intelligence/Systems/Information Security Analyst, Enterprise Information Analyst	Bring together business and information technology (IT) by understanding computer systems and procedures in order to design solutions to help them operate more efficiently and effectively.  <b>Tech Skills:</b> Cloud Platforms, Programming Languages (Java)
<b>Systems Support</b>	ADP, Oracle, Insight	Technical Support/Technical Sales/Infrastructure/Security Support and IT User Liaison	Analyze, troubleshoot, and evaluate computer network problems. Provide assistance to people and organizations using computer software or equipment.  <b>Tech Skills:</b> Operating Systems (Microsoft, Linux)
<b>Technical Sales</b>	IBM, Cisco, Siemens, Dell	Business Development Associate, Account Manager, Sales Consultant	Focus on complex and technical products for businesses.
