O-MSA/O-MBA Dual Degree (Online Master of Science in Accounting / Online MBA)

The Dual O-MSA/O-MBA degree program is recommended for students wishing to pursue a career in accounting and/or business administration. The dual degree program is particularly well suited for students that do not have a business undergraduate degree and would like to obtain a broad range of business knowledge along with a specialization in accounting.

In general, the Dual O-MSA/O-MBA degree can be completed in as little as two years. The student must be admitted to both the O-MSA and O-MBA programs. University policy on dual degrees stipulates that a maximum of 50% of the credit hours for the shorter program may be counted toward both degrees. Therefore, the O-MSA/O-MBA degree requires a total of 60 units.

In summary:

The student must meet the prerequisite requirements for both degrees.

O-MSA Degree requirements: 30 units of coursework

O-MBA Degree requirements: 45 units of coursework

However, up to 15 units of course work may be counted toward both degrees.

30 + 45 - 15 = 60 Total Units
